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NEWS LETTER FENCE UPDATE

As you may have seen a representative from Countrywide, together with a representative of Fenland District Council, and the fencing contractor were on site Tuesday 27th November examining the work recently carried out on the boundary fence.

Fenland District Council agreed that although some progress had been made in making the boundary fence more secure, there was still more work which needed to be undertaken, in order to comply with the court ruling. Countrywide have therefore verbally agreed that the contractor will return in a couple of weeks, to put in extra support posts and kick boards, however, where the requirement is for replacement of arris rails this work will not be undertaken until the Spring/Summer of 2019 when the weather, hopefully, will be better for undertaking such work, and the work will be done in sections, rather than all at once.

Whilst this is not the most suitable of solutions, it does at least address the immediate issue of the fence possibly collapsing should we get strong winds during the winter period.

Countrywide have also, again verbally, agreed to remove the garden area at the front entrance to the park and move the notice board and salt bin to this area, hence making more room for visitor parking. They will also be looking to widen the bend outside No.1 by redesigning the road at this junction.

The committee will be writing to Countrywide to confirm what was verbally discussed and to invite them to attend a meeting prior to next year's AGM to discuss other issues, including dividing fences, water rates etc in the hope that these issues can be resolved and reported on at the AGM.

The issues that some of you raised with committee prior to the meeting on site were discussed and will be included in correspondence to Countrywide.

Once we know when the contractor will be on site to carry out the immediate installation of posts we will notify members.

The GPRA has welcomed new residents to the park, No.26 Carol and No. 27 Andy & Julie and we hope that they will be a integral part of the community.
