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NHW Burglary and Other Crime Update

Dear NHW Coordinator

Recently in Wisbech, two potential offenders were reported to be acting suspiciously in a rear garden. One person has been arrested for burglary offences.

In Chatteris, two people were arrested for burglary crimes. The level of reported burglaries in that area has declined significantly since their arrest. They have been before the Courts. We remain committed to reducing this type of crime and will continue to keep you updated.

There has been a spate of car break-ins in the Benwick Coates and Eastrea (F13A) area, of both locked and unlocked vehicles, the locked ones having windows smashed to gain entry.

As there are only a small number of domestic burglary or shed break-ins, I am listing them all and sending just this one update to all NHW Coordinators across Fenland. In future my aim is to email the four neighbourhoods separately to focus on their particular wards.

F11A	09/04/2016 10:00 - 12/04/2016 21:00	Morton Avenue March	30/30 - Burglary (shed/garage) Between the stated times an unknown offender has forced the supporting wall to the victim's garage. It is presumed this is an attempt to force entry, the victim does not believe entry has been gained at this time
F12C	16/04/2016 12:00 - 17/04/2016 12:15	The Green Chatteris	30/30 - Burglary (shed/garage) 2 sheds in rear garden broken in to - nothing appears to have been stolen.
F21G	12/04/2016 00:00 - 12/04/2016 00:13	Colville Road Wisbech	28/2 - Burglary in a dwelling with commission of an offence Unknown offender(s) have entered the property through the unlocked side door and stolen the laptop and xbox from the living room, person(s) have also gone upstairs and entered the victim's bedroom which has woken him up, they have then run off and exited via the same side door.
F21J	15/04/2016 10:00 - 15/04/2016 10:18	Sutton Road Leverington	28/2 - Burglary in a dwelling with commission of an offence 2 suspects acted together. Entered via rear door (lock snapping) searched house, took jewellery and cash in rucksack stolen from scene also. Disturbed by police and one offender arrested near scene
