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JULY NEWS LETTER

Sadly we begin with the sad news of the passing of three members of our community. Mr Barker (No.1), Mr Ron Forbes (No.39) and Mrs Barbara Jeffcote (No.30) it is always sad to report this news, and we are sure that all our members would wish the committee to send their condolences to members of their families.

The committee would like to suggest that in light of some issues that arose during the illness and deaths of our residents that a central data base be held with basic details of whom to contact in the event of illness, this need only be contact Mrs ABC phone number and possibly Mr ABC holds a key to the home, whilst some residents may have already given this information to a neighbour, should that neighbour not be around if something unforeseen happens then as a community we should be looking out for each other.

Countrywide have sent copies of the Fire Risk Assessment Review 2018, Certificate of Inspection Fire Extinguishers, Combined Liability Insurance and Caravan and Park Home Site Insurance, all of which will be posted on our web site. At this time we are unable to put them in the Notice Box, due to not having a key, however, they will be held by the Secretary should any wish to inspect them. The committee will endeavour to obtain a key so that they can be placed correctly in the notice box. When a copy of the Park Rules will also be included, and for everyone's information a copy of the Park Rules is attached to this New Letter, which we would ask you all to read and adhere to, especially in light of the fact that Countrywide will be appearing in court on 21st August 2018 for non compliance to Council Licence regulations. Members of the committee will attend the court hearing and will report back to members.

People may have heard rumours that the land to the rear of the site has had planning permission requested for 100 mobile homes, however, Fenland Council Planning Office have confirmed in writing that no application has at this time been made for such a development .

Water rates, have again been read, however, a month early and the committee will endeavour to ascertain the reason for this, however, no water rate bills have been received since the last reading was taken in May.

The Committee has met with two local Resident Association's Marham and Yardmill who requested the meetings as they were experiencing problems with their owners and were interested to learn from us how we dealt with similar problems.
