NEWS UPDATE

Dear Member

You may have seen us walking the Park last Friday with a representative from FDC. This was in respect of the ongoing problems relating to the boundary fences and street lighting.

As you are all aware we have been raising these issues with Countrywide since the inaugural meeting of the GPRA.

Today we have received written confirmation from FDC that they have written to Countrywide and given them 2 weeks' notice to confirm when they proposed to carry out the repair work, if they fail to comply with this request then FDC will initiate a Compliance Notice under 9a of The Mobiles Homes Act 2013.

At this time we would also like to update you on the progress we have made with FDC regarding the neglected nursery behind the east boundary fence. We continue to be in contact with the planning office who have made visits to the owners of the nursery, they owners have stated that at this time they are only clearing the site and have not put in any submission for planning. The planning department have requested us to keep them informed of any going movement on the site and we would request those of you who back onto this ground to be vigilant and if possible take photo's of any work being carried out of parking of vehicles, preferably date stamped photo's and either submit them direct to the planning department of FDC or send them to a committee member.

We continue to post on our web site correspondence and photographic evidence of all matters relating to the Park.
